Classes and student residences are in the heart of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea; home to many of the city's universities, libraries, museums, and theaters. Past students have traveled internationally to the European Continent as well as to other parts of England such as Stonehenge, the ancient city of Bath, The Royal Military Academy at Sandhurst (the British equivalent of West Point), and the Lake District.
