Citadel Summer in Ecuador

The Citadel Program in Ecuador will take place in Cuenca. Students will study Spanish language and culture during 4 weeks and will earn 6 credit hours. Cuenca is considered the most beautiful city in Ecuador. It is located in the southern sierra of the Andes, with a population of 600,000, making it Ecuador's third largest city. Cuenca is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site due to its stunning well preserved colonial architecture. Cuencan culture and history can be experienced through its many museums, churches, festivals and historical sites. Students will live with local families and experience local food and culture. They will do excursions to the famous Inca ruins called Ingapirca and the National Park El Cajas, and visit local towns like Gualaceo, Chordeleg, and Saraguro.
