ABOUT CUENCA:

Cuenca is a beautiful and colorful city in the southern sierra of the **Andes**. It is the capital of Azuay province, with a population of 600,000., making it Ecuador's third largest city. Cuenca is considered the most beautiful city in Ecuador. The city is located on the banks of the **Rio Tomebamba**. Cuenca is listed as a **UNESCO World Heritage Site** due to its stunning well preserved colonial architecture.

Cuencan culture and history can be experienced through its many museums, churches, and historical sites. North Cuenca, in the Cañar province, is home for the **Cañari indígenas** and the famous Inca ruins called **Ingapirca**. Cuenca area also offers an amazing variety for excursions to the country like the towns of **Gualaceo, Chordeleg, and Saraguro**. It also offers amazing opportunities for wilderness adventures, hiking and trekking like **El Cajas National Park**, (9,000-13,000 ft).
